



DYNEVER GARDENING ASSOCIATION PLOT ALLOCATION POLICY

This policy is made on the basis that all plots whether full, half or quarter plots are all fully occupied and there is a waiting list of persons wanting to take up a plot on the on the Association's site at the Creigiau Recreation Field.

- 1 If a full plot is vacated, that plot will normally be offered to four people as quarter plots and the allocation of those quarter plots will be made in accordance with the following provisions.
 - 1.1 Should a quarter plot become available, the person at the top of the waiting list will be contacted and offered the plot.
 - 1.2 The availability of plots will be made known to all existing members. If an existing member with a quarter plot indicates that he/she wishes to increase their plot size, that existing member may be given priority over those on the waiting list if the vacant plot is adjacent to their current plot.
- 2 No member, either by him/herself or with another, shall have more than a half plot at any time
- 3 The provision set out at 1.2 above shall operate at the discretion of the Management Committee of the Association and the strict observance of the Rules of the Association by any member wishing to take advantage of this provision will be of the utmost importance in the practice of that discretion.
- 4 Only those living in the Pentyrch Community Council area will be eligible to be placed on the waiting list and therefore become members of the Association.
